




2021 Housing Inventory Count




The Portsmouth Homeless Action Consortium (PHAC) compiled the annual Housing Inventory Count (HIC) in conjunction with the Point In Time (PIT) Count on January 27-28, 2021. The pie chart illustrates the proportion of beds available by project type as reported for the 2021 HIC. The bar chart below demonstrates the utilization rates for each project during the PIT Count. Together, the HIC and PIT Count provide needed information on how well the current level of housing inventory meets the community's housing needs.


PHAC 2021 Housing Inventory Count Bed Inventory by Project Type

The Housing Inventory Count also tracks how year-round housing resources are dedicated by household types. Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) projects primarily serve households *without* children, with 61.8% of beds serving single adult households.

However, Emergency Shelter (ES) and Rapid Rehousing projects predominately assist households *with* children by 62.6% & 70.2%, respectively.


Between 2020 and 2021, there was two major changes in the PSH inventory: the first, a correction on the HIC designating 60 beds as Other Permanent Housing from PSH; and the second, the reallocation of 12 Transitional Housing beds to PSH beds during the 2020 grant cycle.

The Portsmouth CoC was able to increase bed inventory among the Rapid Rehousing projects by 59.3% (35 beds).


The decrease in Seasonal ES beds and the increase in Year-Round ES beds is partially due to the inflow of funding in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, allowing supportive funding for a seasonal shelter to operate year round and hotel/motel shelter projects.

From 2020 to 2021, there was a 14.7% decrease among all ES projects, from 95 beds in 2020 to 81 beds in 2021.

Since 2012, the Portsmouth CoC has increased Permanent Supportive Housing inventory by 10.3%, from 145 beds in 2012 to 160 beds in 2021.

Overall, the CoC's Housing Inventory has grown from 348 total beds in 2012 up to 405 total beds in 2021, an increase by 16.3%.
