Summit Objectives:

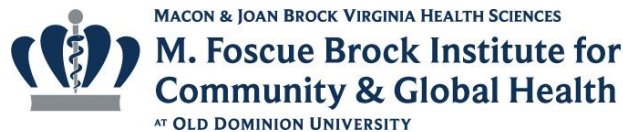
- Describe national, state, regional, and local data on community violence and its impacts on mental health wellness.
